CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES: Million Dollar “Hole In One”

ELIGIBILITY: THIS IS A CONTEST (A GAME OF SKILL). The Million Dollar “Hole In One” Contest is open to all golfers, who is at least 18 years of age, and who register and purchase a “Hole-In-One Ball” at Paradise Valley Golf Course. This contest is for AMATEURS only. Prizes will not be awarded to Professional Golfers. Contest is open to all Sponsors.

Definitions:

“Amateur” one who golfs as a non-remunerative non-profit-making sport and does not receive remuneration for teaching golf or for other activities because of golf skill or reputation.

“Club Professional ” means anyone who earns their living employed by a golf course to play or teach golf. Does not include a touring pro.

“Hole In One” means a hole (where the ball comes to rest completely in the cup) made in one stroke from the corresponding tee. As per the rules of golf: The first player is allowed 50 seconds to play his shot from the moment he arrives at the ball, while the second and third players are only allowed 45 seconds.

SPONSOR: Big Brothers Big Sisters, Association of Medicine Hat & District.

LIMITATIONS: The Contest is only open to participants during the specified times of contest and daylight hours. Prizes will not be awarded except during these hours.

Qualification Period Sept 9 – 11 - (3:00 – 6:00 p.m.)

Semi Finalists – Top “15” Sept 11 - (6:30 p.m.)

Grand Finalists – Top “5” ... Sept 12 – (2:00 p.m.)

HOW TO ENTER: Eligible persons (“Player”) who:

Must be at least 18 years of age

Register for contest and purchase qualifying balls (3 balls for \$10.00) to participate in the Contest

Agree to be bound by the terms of the Official Rules and shall automatically be entered in the Contest. A Player shall receive a card with a code for Validation. A card with validation code may only be used by the Player for the SHOT purchased when the Ticket was issued, inclusive of rain-checks or other weather related delay.

If weather delay occurs, Sponsor, has the right to reschedule the contest to a date held within 90 days.

There is “one” possible winning shot (“Hole In One”). The winning shot is defined as follows:

Hole In One

QUALIFYING ROUNDS:

During the qualifying rounds, hit a ball inside a 20 foot circle from 100 yards to qualify.

Everyday, you may shoot as many times as you want to qualify for a spot in the Top “5”.

Top 5, score from each day, will advance to the Semi Finalist shoot out, Saturday, September 11, 2010, 6:30 p.m.

SEMI FINALISTS:

Top “15” Semi Finalists, will compete also from 100 yards away, to advance to a spot in the “TOP 5” Grand finalists.

Top "5" Grand Finalist spots will be determined by "Closest to the Pin".

All cards shall be completed by participant and validated by Tournament Official

Only a "HOLE IN ONE" in the Grand Finals will be awarded the 1 Million Dollar Prize. A Hole In One in a previous round will be considered the closest to the Pin for that round.

In the event of a tie, in any particular day, a shoot out will commence and closest to the Pin will be determined. If you have qualified for the top "5" of the day, you have secured a spot in the Top "15" Semi Finalists.

Top "5" Grand Finalists will compete for the "MILLION DOLLAR Hole In One" on Sunday, September 12, 2010, 2:00 p.m.

GRAND FINALISTS - ELIGIBLE SHOT IN THE TOP "5" GRAND FINALS: A "shot" is defined as a "stroke" by the (RCGA) Rules of Golf. In order for a shot to be eligible, it must be taken by an officially pre-registered and/or pre-qualified contestant whose amateur status is correctly specified on Certificate. EPA is not obligated to reimburse its members for a prize if the winner's amateur or professional status is not correctly specified on the Certificate.

A winning shot must be hit from a minimum distance as follows: All participants - 160 yards.

Only one shot per contestant per target hole is permitted in the "Grand Finals".

No practice shots, mulligans, or substituted shots for other contestants are permitted.

Certificate of achievement shall be made on the Participant card, achieving the Hole In One, by the tournament official monitoring play at selected Hole.

Two (2) Tournament officials shall be stationed and monitoring play at selected Hole during the covered tournament

A ball hit out of bounds and replayed does not qualify.

GOLF Professionals are not eligible for prizes.

PRIZE REDEMPTION: Should the Player claim a WINNING Shot

40 Year Annuity

Prizes are not transferrable, assignable or redeemable for cash.

Players who hit a Hole-In-One will be required to provide Sponsor an affidavit, and contact information including name, address, and telephone numbers.

Failure to provide this information shall disqualify the Player from claim payment. By accepting the Prize and participating in the Contest, Player agrees to release name and video to Sponsor for promotional purposes.

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY: By entering this Contest, each Player agrees to be bound by the Terms and Conditions of these Contest Official Rules, and the decisions are final and not subject to challenge. Sponsor owns all pictures, film and references captured by the cameras or other devices. Sponsor, Golf Course, and their related, affiliated and subsidiary companies, officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents or independent contractors are not responsible for claims, injuries, losses or damages of any kind resulting from participation in Contest, or acceptance or misuse, malfunctioning, possession, loss or misdirection of any Prize. Tickets can not be transferred, resold or offered for sale. Sponsor, the Golf Course, and their related, affiliated and subsidiary companies, officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents or independent contractors are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged cards or for ticket errors, printer errors or inaccurate, incomplete, stolen, lost, illegible, mutilated, or misdirected tickets or other entry, or equipment or telephone malfunction.

MISCONDUCT: Tee markers may not be moved or adjusted by Players. By entering, Players acknowledge compliance to these Contest Official Rules including all eligibility requirements. Any attempt to deliberately

damage the content or operation of this Contest is unlawful and subject to legal action by the Sponsor or its agents. If any equipment or mechanical malfunction, error, disruption or damage occurs, impairing the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper play of the Contest, Sponsor, may in its sole discretion, suspend or terminate the Contest. Any Player found tampering with, hacking, cheating, or abusing any aspect of the System, or whom the Sponsor believes to be causing malfunction, error, disruption, damage or in any unsportsmanlike manner, attempts to take unfair advantage, will automatically disqualified and prosecuted.
